## Faith Covenant Fellowship — Service Animal Policy

Faith Covenant Fellowship welcomes trained service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Service animals are individually trained to perform specific tasks for individuals with disabilities. Service animals must remain under their handler's control at all times while on church property.

For the safety, comfort, and worship experience of our congregation—particularly those with allergies, medical needs, or fears—pets and emotional support animals are not permitted inside our buildings or children's ministry environments.

To verify that an animal qualifies as a service animal, our team may ask the two questions permitted under ADA guidelines:

- Is the service animal required because of a disability?
- 2. What specific task has the animal been trained to perform?

These questions are used solely to ensure compliance with the ADA. Our team will not request documentation, certification, or details about a person's disability.
